The certification process involves years of training and intense practical examination, which requires a very high level of commitment, skill and professionalism.



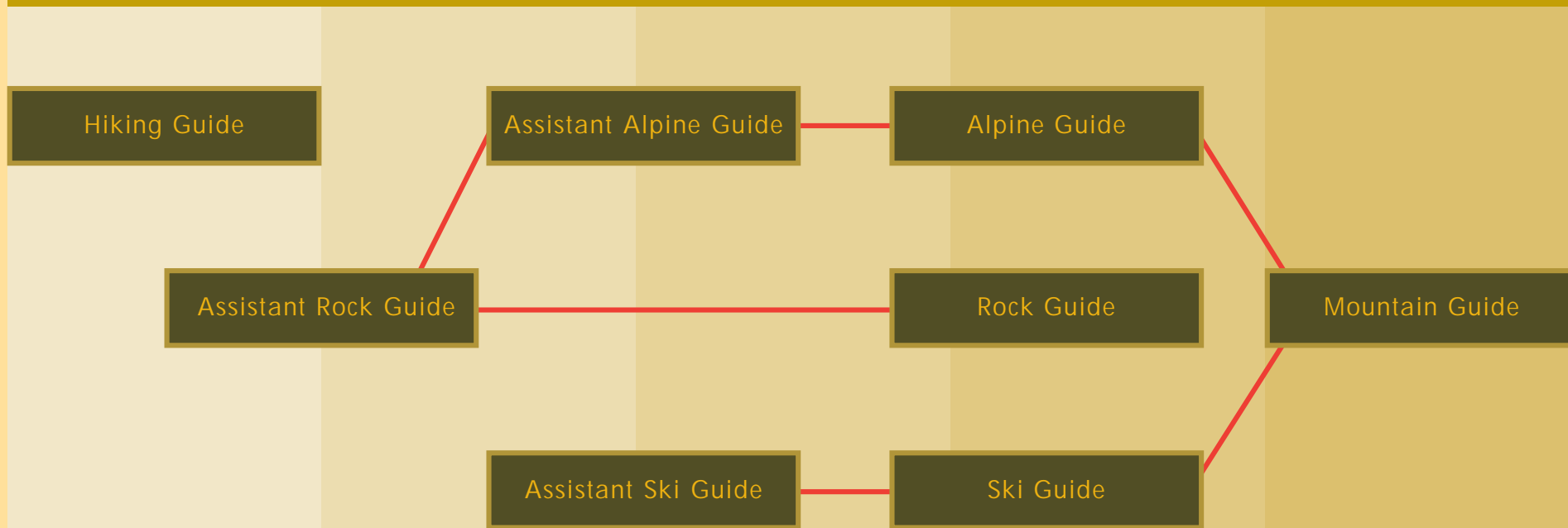

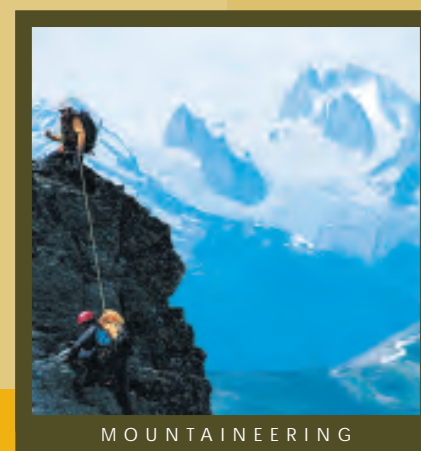

Professional Mountain Guides have been employed in Europe since the 1870's. The first certified, professional mountain guides arrived in Canada from Switzerland in 1899. The following organizations are a proud part of that legacy:



*The Association of Canadian Mountain Guides (ACMG) was founded in 1963 by Hans Gmoser – founder of CMH – Leo Grillmair and several other guides to establish a high standard of mountain guiding in the National Parks. In 1972 the ACMG was accepted into the IFMGA and has been a member of the international guiding community ever since. It has now become the standard for certification throughout our industry.*



*The International Federation of Mountain Guides Association (IFMGA) was founded in Europe in 1966 with the aim of maintaining a high standard of mountain guiding amongst its member countries, which include Canada, Switzerland, Germany, Austria, France, Italy, Britain, New Zealand, Peru, Japan, the United States and several others.*
